I would like to see him use his words to give messages more often then just crying when a situation upsets him.

Noah has a strong ability to concentrate on something that interests him. He is able to build towers, classify objects and make astute observations about other people and events. He is definitely ready to move up to preschool and keep exploring new things! I would like to see him be able to focus on tasks like eating lunch and pottying just as well as he does other things.






